# FIONA STANLEY HOSPITAL

- ▶ 783 beds, including 140-bed State rehabilitation service
- ▶ 83% single patient rooms in main hospital
- ▶ 6,300 rooms in the main hospital
- ▶ 16 wards (of 24 beds each)
- ▶ 29 imaging rooms
- ▶ 15 theatres plus 3 shelled
- ▶ 135,000m<sup>2</sup> gross area (excluding car parks)
- ▶ 15km from Perth CBD – Easy to access
- ▶ Facilities Management Contract



# KEY SERVICES & FACILITIES

- ▶ Full range of acute medical and surgical services
- ▶ State burns service
- ▶ State rehabilitation service
- ▶ State-of-the-art emergency department
- ▶ Cardiothoracics including advanced heart and lung transplant
- ▶ Comprehensive cancer services including radiotherapy oncology, medical oncology and haematology (state bone marrow transplant service)
- ▶ Renal transplantation and dialysis services
- ▶ Acute mental health
- ▶ Nuclear medicine
- ▶ Women's, children & neonates



# WORLD CLASS TECHNOLOGY

- ▶ State of the art technology to deliver new levels of patient care and convenience
- ▶ Wireless Information and Communications Technology systems that will store all information electronically
- ▶ Videoconferencing services for clinical, consultative, training and administrative purposes
- ▶ Patient Entertainment Systems to be used by patients (meal ordering, TV, internet etc), and clinical staff (x-ray and scan transmission, medication management, patient administration etc).



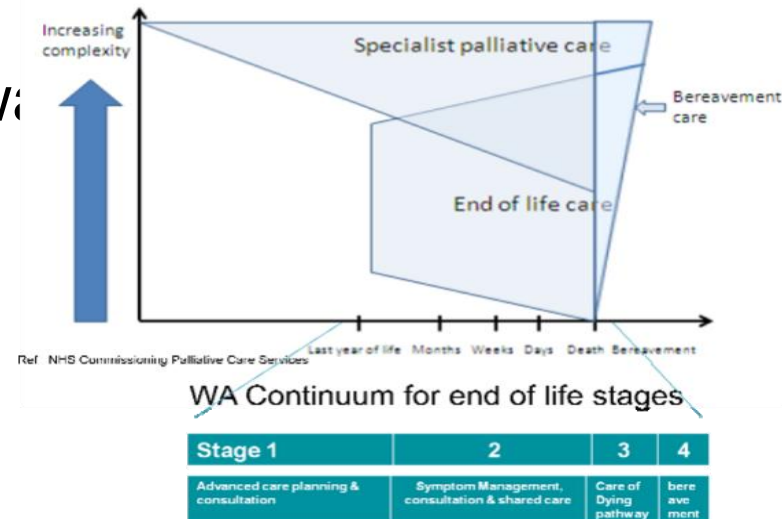
# FSH END OF LIFE SERVICES

- ▶ Palliative Care Service
- ▶ Acute – end of life interface
  - ▶ ICU – 40 bed, single rooms, co-located with CCU
  - ▶ Recognising and Managing the Deteriorating Patient
    - ▶ ADDS & CEWT
  - ▶ MET response
  - ▶ Acute pain service
- ▶ Supportive Care
  - ▶ Bereavement Service
  - ▶ Pastoral Care



# PALLIATIVE CARE SERVICE

- ▶ Consultancy Service - Focused on capacity building within other specialities
- ▶ Service delivery follows the continuum for end of life
  - **Stage 1** - Advancing Disease - Advance Care Planning
  - **Stage 2** - Increasing Decline - Palliative Care consultation and / or ongoing shared care with primary treating speciality
  - **Stage 3** - WA Liverpool Care Pathway For the Dying Patient
  - **Stage 4** - Bereavement follow-up
